Do you suffer from a medical condition or allergies that may be affected by your volunteering in the attraction? Volunteer haunters will be subject to flashing lights, loud noises, perpetual darkness, fog/smoke, and other extreme conditions.

*Please note that The 13th Ward runs from 7:30pm-11pm each night that it is open. Volunteers will be assigned to work as an actor, retail sales, or other position based on the need for each night. Once placed in a room you are expected to stay in that position all night, there is NO roaming from room to room. Volunteers are expected to arrive at 6pm and usually leave around 11:30 p.m.-12:00 a.m. Refreshments will be provided at the haunt for volunteers. Full-time volunteers receive one t-shirt for volunteering. If not acting in the house you will be expected to wear the t-shirt during haunt hours. Volunteers must wear an approved costume by The 13th Ward. We will also be giving out prizes for best haunters, etc. at the end of the season party.

Important Information

Volunteers agreeing to participate in volunteer activities must recognize and appreciate that there are always inherent risks of injury associated with any volunteer activities. Such risks will vary depending upon the nature of the particular volunteer activity.

Please recognize that The 13th Ward does not carry medical/accident insurance for injuries sustained in its volunteer programs.
